Following are several community resources that may be of help to someone experiencing a mental health crisis and needing immediate access to care. We encourage you or a loved one to contact these or other helping services until you feel you have received the support you need including follow-up or ongoing care.

## NATIONAL & STATEWIDE

### **HENNEPIN COUNTY**

Hennepin County COPE--Community Outreach for (Adult) Psychiatric Emergencies--(612-596-1223): 24/7 outreach to <u>adults</u> located in Hennepin County experiencing psychiatric emergency. Call COPE to consult about clients who you are very concerned about.

**Hennepin County APS--Acute Psychiatric Services--(612-873-3161):** 24/7 assessment for adults for hospitalization for psychiatric emergencies. ER entrance to Hennepin County Medical Center, 701 Park Ave. S. Minneapolis

**Hennepin County Child Crisis Services (612-348-2233):** Mobile outreach for child/adolescent located in Hennepin County and experiencing a mental health emergency.

**Abbott Northwestern Hospital ER for adults:** 800 East 28th St, Minneapolis. ER entrance is on 10th Ave. between 26th and 28th St. For access to Adolescent Mental Health Services (612-863-8633)

**Fairview-University Medical Center (612-672-6600):** Assessment and inpatient services for <u>children and</u> <u>adolescents</u> experiencing a mental health emergency. ER entrance at 2450 Riverside Ave., Minneapolis.

## **RAMSEY COUNTY**

**Regions Hospital Crisis Program (651-254-1000):** 24/7 assessment for <u>adult</u> psychiatric emergencies and possible hospitalization. ER entrance at 640 Jackson St., St. Paul.

**Ramsey County** (<u>Adult</u> Mental Health) Urgent Care (651-266-7900): Phone, walk-in, mobile outreach to assess and coordinate adult psychiatric emergencies in Ramsey County. Walk-in 8 – 5 weekdays. 24-hour crisis line: 651-266-7900. There is a fee for urgent care services. They will bill insurance if available or offer a variety of payment options including an income-based sliding fee scale.

**Ramsey County** <u>Children's</u> Crisis Response (651-266-7878): 24/7 crisis services for children and adolescents located in Ramsey County and experiencing a mental health emergency.

United Hospital <u>Adolescent</u> (12 to 18) Mental Health Treatment Unit (651-241-8694): 333 North Smith Ave. Call first.

**Fairview-University Medical Center (612-672-6600):** Assessment and inpatient services for <u>children and</u> <u>adolescents</u> experiencing a mental health emergency. ER entrance at 2450 Riverside Ave., Minneapolis.

## SUBURBAN COUNTY CRISIS INTERVENTION
